Volunteers Needed for Lead & Copper Water Sampling!

CMCMD's Water & Sanitation department is looking for volunteers to help with this very important drinking water sampling program. Colorado's *lead and copper* monitoring schedule requires us to collect water samples from homes throughout the resort. These samples will help confirm that our water at Copper Mountain, as well as our distribution system and the pipes of your home, continues to meet Colorado's standards for safe drinking water.

If you're willing to participate, we'd appreciate your help. Collecting a sample is easy, and your participation helps us complete this important testing for our community.

The process is very simple ...

- Our operations staff will either collect the sample from your home at your convenience, or we will supply you with a collection bottle and instructions for you to take the sample yourself.
- We will have the water analyzed at a certified laboratory at absolutely no cost to the homeowner or property manager.
- We will provide you with the results, and an interpretation of them, for your home.

Some additional information ...

- We need to sample from at least 20 different residences, but additional homes are welcome.
- Sampling needs to be completed by September 30th.
- We do this sampling every 3 years.
